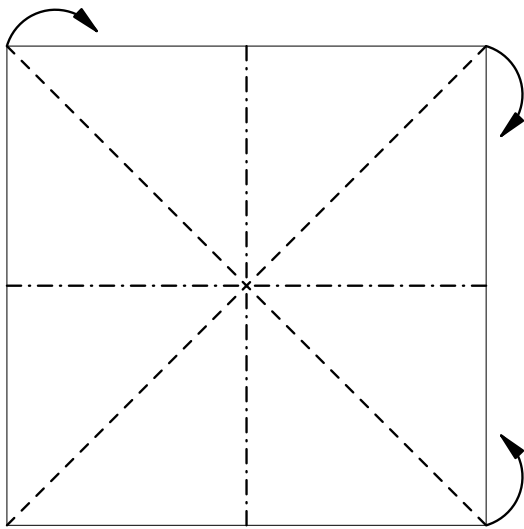
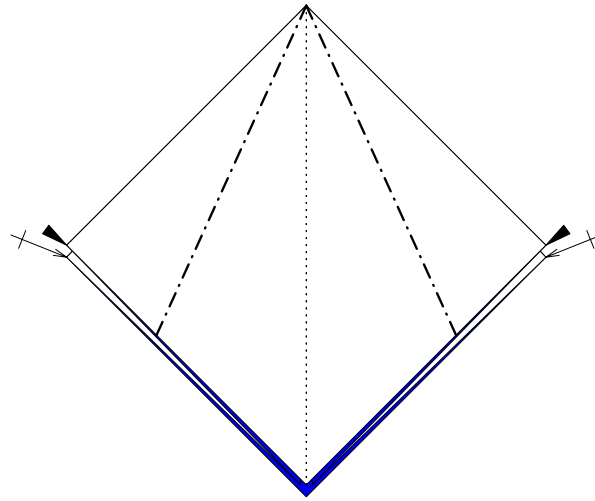


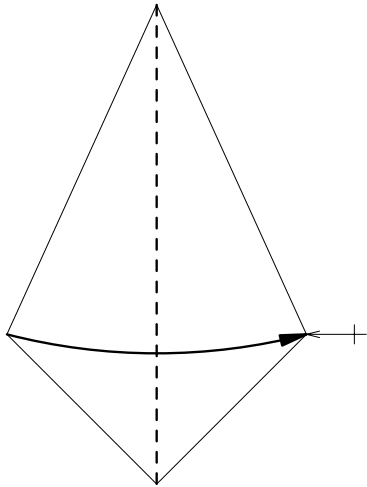
To make a life size hat start with a square meter.
 You may first try and fold a smaller model, but start with a square of
 at least 24 cm (10 inch).



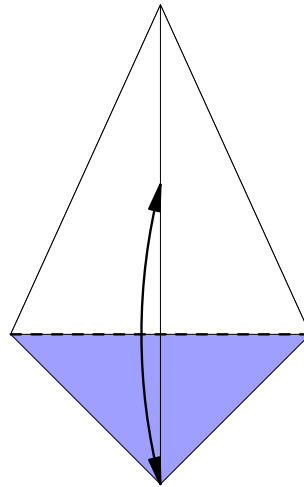
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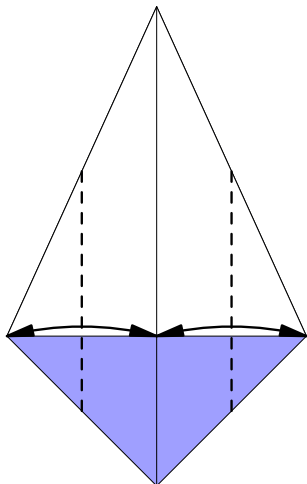
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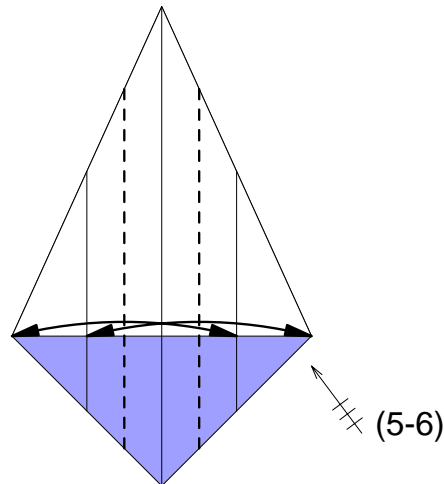
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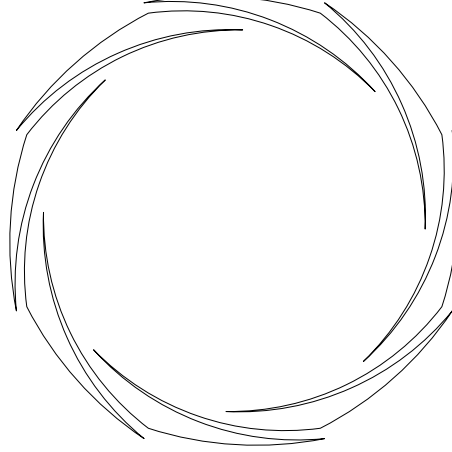
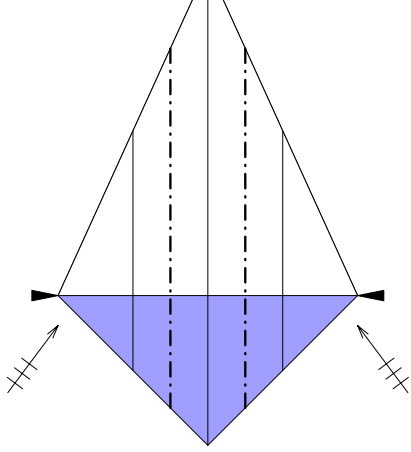

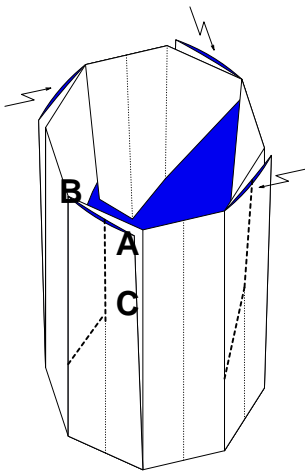


6 Repeat diagram 5 and 6 on other flaps.



7 Open the model slightly -> 3D.
Push in the closed top -> flat.
Inside reverse fold all 8 flaps.
Flaps should point inside in a
spiral way.

8 View in open side.
Fold the four flaps inside
the model on creases made
in diagram 4 to lock.



9 Slide all layers at A under flap
B while zigzag folding at C.
Repeat on other 3 locations.
The open end of the model shrinks
in diameter; push it a bit inside
the 'balloon'.
When making a life size hat you
should experiment with the exact
location of the vertical valley
folds to fit the hat on your head.
