


1. Start with a square white side up, fold both sides in to the center.

2. Valley fold 3. Unfold the the top flap sides outwards. down.




4. Fold sides in to the center flap.







6. Pull out the hidden corners.




7. reverse fold the corners inwards, then unfold the top flap.




8. mountain fold in half.




9. Reverse fold the big flap and rotate the model.





11. Sink (multiple reverse folds) repeat behind.




12. Spread sink. (this means to spread it out while sinking.)




