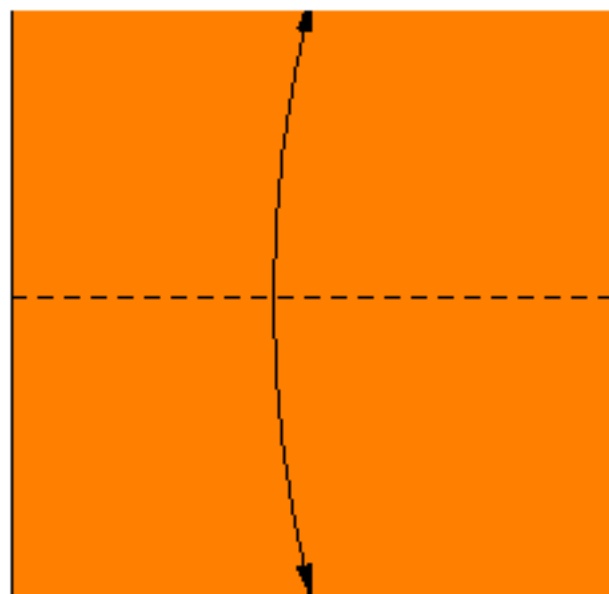
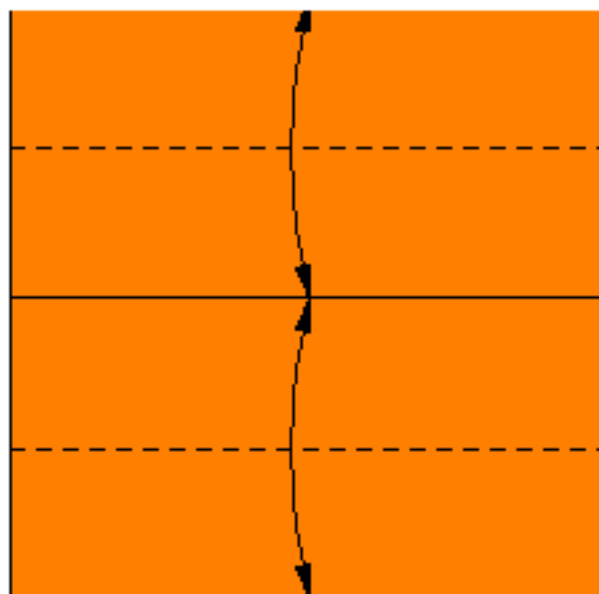


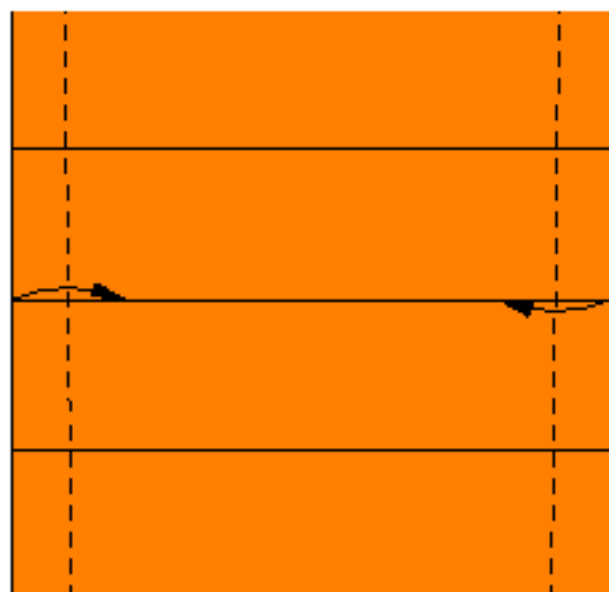
Take 5 sheets together and fold as shown in diagram 1 and 2.
 First fold is always a correct bookfold through the center of the sheet.
 The folds in diagram 2 are for sheet 1 exactly in 4 equal parts.
 In the remaining sheets these folds are stepwise wider from the center crease.
 The folding method for sheet 1 and the remaining sheets differs in step 3.



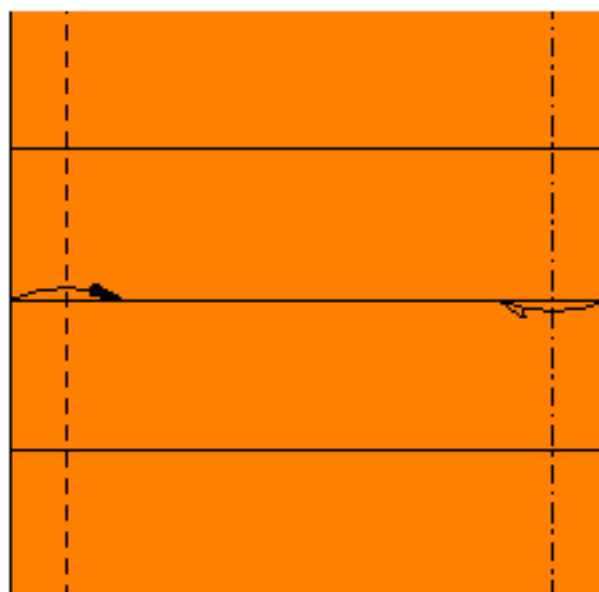

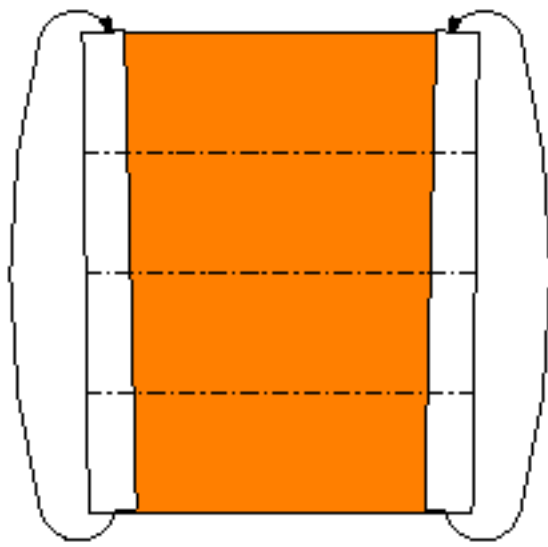
2 First fold sheet 1 : exactly divide in four
 Then take all 5 sheets together and fold in half.
 Fold the creases of this diagram in all 5 sheets
 at the same time, around sheet 1. So they get
 step by step wider.



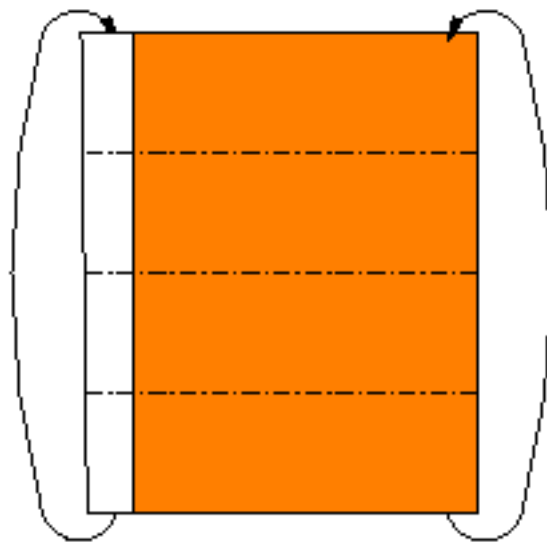
3A Sheet 1 :
 Creases are a little bit slanting.



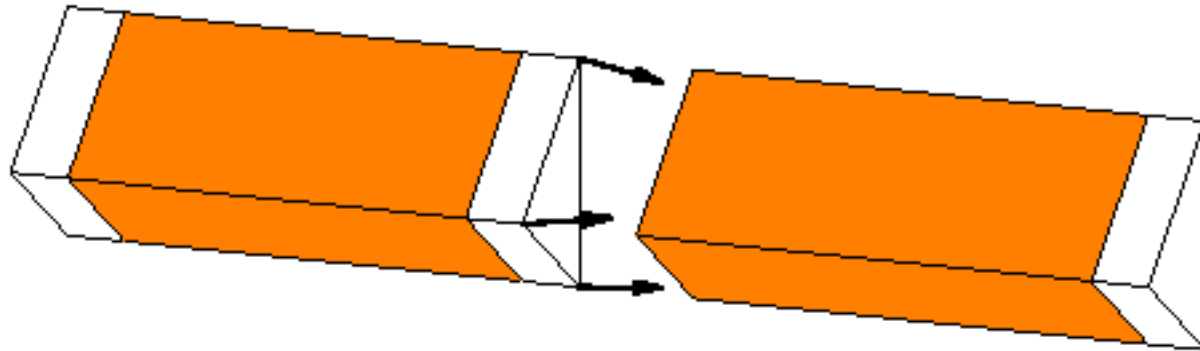
3B Remaining sheets:
 Creases are parallel to the rough edge.



4A Sheet 1 : Make a triangular tube and slide bottom side in top side.



4B Other sheets: Make a triangular tube and slide bottom side in top side.



5 Slide sheet 1 in sheet 2.
And this in sheet 3 and then in sheet 4 and 5.
